The events organized during the year – 2010 are-

1. IAP Pedigastro 2010: -

National CME of the IAP Pediatric Gastro-enterology, Hepatology & nutrition Chapter was held at Hotel Hindustan International, Bhubaneswar from 12th – 13th June, 2010. 4. World Breast Feeding Week: -

IAP Orissa State Branch celebrated the world breast feeding week from 1st-7th August 2010 and involved NGOs to disseminate the massage of Breast feeding to the society. Leaflets depicting benefits of breast feeding and importance of IMS Act 1992

were distributed to mothers in postnatal and pediatric ward of hospitals and to mothers at anganwadi centers in all slums in Bhubaneswar. The other highlights of the week are-
